Deepak Obhrai—Bio

Deepak Obhrai has been a federal MP in the Canadian Parliament since 1997. In this current Parliament, Obhrai was appointed Parliamentary Secretary for Foreign Affairs and is the government's representative on the Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs and International Development. He also serves as the chair of the Canada-India Parliamentary Friendship Group.

Obhrai remains committed to ensuring that the voices of Canada's multicultural communities are heard in Ottawa. In 2006, in recognition of the positive role he has played over the past 25 years in strengthening ties between Canada and South Asia, Deepak was honoured with awards from the Indo-Canada Chamber of Commerce Ottawa Business Council and from the National Indo-Canadian Council.

A new era of peace and cooperation in the African Great Lakes Region

Deepak Obhrai represented the Canadian Government at the second Summit of the International Conference on the Great Lakes Region in Nairobi, Kenya, from December 14 to 15, 2006.

The conference's objective was to encourage the countries of the region to agree on a strategy and concrete actions that will bring peace, stability and prosperity to the African Great Lakes region.

It focused on peace and security, democracy and good governance, economic development and

regional integration, and humanitarian and social issues.

The conference shows a desire of the region's countries to transfer themselves from conflict situations into accepting conditions of democracy and dialogue.
